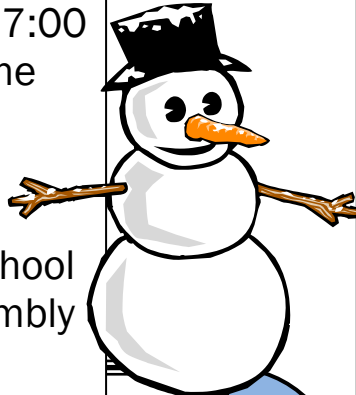

What we are learning this month:

Math: Place value to 1,000; Reading, writing, and comparing numbers to 1,000; Adding three-digit numbers; Continued practice on basic addition/subtraction facts.

Reading/Language Arts: soft c & g sounds; consonant digraphs; main idea/details; prefixes/suffixes; kinds of nouns; narrative nonfiction and expository text

Science: Types of matter; animal habitats

Social Studies: Kansas Day symbols and facts; Martin Luther King Jr. activities

PLEASE make sure your child is completing their nightly reading. Students should be reading at least 15-20 minutes EVERY evening as part of their homework. ONLY sign their reading calendar if they read. Students should also be taking at least one Accelerated Reader (AR) test each week unless they are reading a thick chapter book. We use AR tests to monitor comprehension. If students are reading each night, they should easily be ready for an AR test each week. Our recent reading scores are reflecting good progress in reading.
